1538 13 Jan 2016: Security Forces responded to a report of a stray animal located on Yuma Road. Security Forces made contact with the owner but was unable to retrieve the animal.

1855 13 Jan 2016: Security Forces responded to F St and Colorado Ave to an individual driving a motorcycle on the grass between the parking lot and the dormitory. Security Forces made contact with the individual and requested to see a competency card which the individual could not provide. The individual was apprehended and charged with Negligent Dereliction of Duty and Reckless Driving.

1336 18 Jan 2016: Security Forces responded to the Presidential Inn for a loud noise complaint. Investigation revealed there was a domestic disturbance between two individuals staying in the room. One of the individuals was apprehended and charged with Assault.

2258 20 Jan 2016: Security Forces conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle driving recklessly adjacent to Bldg. 1642. Upon making contact, the driver became verbally aggressive. The individual was apprehended and the vehicle was searched. Upon searching the vehicle, a substance resembling marijuana was located. The substance was tested for Tetrahydrocannabinol and came back positive. The individual was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance and Insubordinate Conduct towards an NCO.

2000 21 Jan 2016: Security Forces responded to a verbal dispute in Liberty Park Base Housing. Investigation revealed two individuals were in a heated discussion when one individual got verbally aggressive. Security Forces advised the individuals the actions were not appropriate and to keep their distance the remainder of the night.

2107 24 Jan 2016: Security Forces received an anonymous report via LiveSafe, reporting a vehicle parked in the middle of an unplowed road. Security Forces responded and made contact with the driver. Investigation revealed the driver's vehicle got stuck in the snow and they went to retrieve a shovel to dig the car out. Security Forces assisted the driver with removing the vehicle.

1405 26 Jan 2016: Security Forces responded to a vehicle accident involving a Government Owned Vehicle in the parking lot of Bldg 5026. Investigation revealed the operator reversed out of a parking spot and came in contact with another vehicle causing minor damages.

2107 27 Jan 2016: Security Forces conducted a traffic stop and smelled an odor resembling marijuana when making contact with the driver. Security Forces received consent to search the vehicle. Upon searching, they located a green leafy substance. The substance was tested for Tetrahydrocannabinol which came back positive. The individual was apprehended and charged with simple possession under the 5th Amendment. The individual was issued an immediate barment letter and was escorted off the installation.

There has been an increase in attempts to enter the installation with a controlled dangerous substance in the vehicle. All vehicles entering the installation are subject to be searched; anyone caught attempting to bring controlled dangerous substances on the installation will be charged and may lose their base privileges.
