## **VOTING ASSISTANCE INFORMATION** FOR MILITARY AND MILITARY DEPENDENTS



Your Installation Voter Assistance Office is here to help you exercise the very right you protect—your right to vote! We can help you register to vote, request an absentee ballot and notify your local election officials back home of a change of address to ensure you receive information in a timely manner.

**Federal Post Card Application (FPCA):** The FPCA can be used to register to vote while simultaneously requesting an absentee ballot. It can also be used to submit a change of address to your local election officials. You can go online to <u>https://www.fvap.gov/r3/fpca/home</u> and use the FPCA Wizard that will help you register, request your absentee ballot, and/or change your address while providing you with all of your state-specific information and requirements to vote.

**Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot (FWAB):** The FWAB can be used as a backup in case you have already registered to vote or sent in an FPCA to both register and request your absentee ballot, but you have not yet received your absentee ballot from your state. Like the FPCA, you can go online to fill in the FWAB at <a href="https://www.fvap.gov/r3/fwab/home">https://www.fvap.gov/r3/fwab/home</a> and use the FWAB Wizard that will help you to vote in Federal elections, even filling in your candidate choices based on your State of residence.

Both the FPCA and FWAB Wizards will provide you with a filled in form. All you have to do is **print, sign and date it**, and return it to your election official via the directions provided (some States allow you to fax, and/or e-mail your signed form).

The Voter Assistance Office can help you fill in and mail off your voting materials if you need the assistance.
