


VOTING ASSISTANCE INFORMATION FOR PCSing, RETIRING, SEPARATING PERSONNEL



Your Installation Voter Assistance Office is here to help you exercise the very right you protect—your right to vote! We can help you register to vote, request an absentee ballot, and notify your local election officials back home of a change of address to ensure you receive information in a timely manner. The information below is provided to help you know what to do when you PCS, deploy or separate/retire.

Federal Post Card Application (FPCA): The FPCA can be used to register to vote while simultaneously requesting an absentee ballot. It can also be used to submit a change of address to your local election officials.

Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot (FWAB): The FWAB can be used as a backup in case you have already registered to vote or sent in an FPCA to both register and request your absentee ballot, but you have not yet received your absentee ballot from your state. The online FWAB Wizard helps you complete the form to vote in Federal elections, even filling in your candidate choices based on your state of residence.

National Mail Voter Registration Form (NVRF): If you are separating or retiring, you will need to advise your local election official that you will no longer be considered a military voter. The NVRF can then be used to notify your local election official of your change of address.

You can now go online to <https://www.fvap.gov/r3/fpca/home> to register, request your absentee ballot, and/or change your address while providing you with all of your state-specific information and requirements to vote. All the forms listed above are available. Wizards will provide you with a filled in form. All you have to do is **print, sign and date it**, and return it to your election official via the directions provided (some States allow you to fax, and/or e-mail your signed form).

The **Installation Voter Assistance Office** can help you fill in and mail off your voting materials if you need the assistance. For more information, you can also contact your **Unit Voting Assistance Counselor** in your squadron for assistance.
