SUBJECT: 2016 Joint Motorcycle Safety Day Designated an Alternate Duty Location

1. As part of the Air Force's ongoing traffic safety efforts, Joint Base Andrews is hosting its sixth annual Joint Motorcycle Safety Day. Join us to hone your skills and refresh your knowledge of local motorcycle specific laws, meet local dealers, riding groups and more. During this event, you will have the opportunity to participate in skill-challenges, watch demonstrations, and compete in a "best bike" contest, while enjoying food, games, prizes, and finalize with a group ride in our local area.

The 2016 Joint Motorcycle Safety Day event will be held at the Motorcycle Safety Foundation training compound next to the base theatre from 0800 to 1500 on 9 June 2016 with a potential rain date of 16 June 2016. It is open to all DoD ID card holders regardless of riding experience. Owning a motorcycle is not a requirement to attend.
3. This event is designated an alternate duty location for civilian and military employees from 0800 to 1500. Employees are allowed to be in attendance unless their supervisor determines it is mission essential for them to remain at work. Both civilian and military attendees are expected to return to their work site after attending the event for any duration of time, unless their shift has ended.
