Col. Jun S. Oh is the commander of the 316th Wing, Air Force District of Washington, and the Installation Commander of Joint Base Andrews-National Air Facility Washington, Maryland. The 316th Wing is the host wing for Joint Base Andrews-National Air Facility Washington, providing security, personnel, contracting, finance, medical and infrastructure support for six wings, three headquarters, and more than 85 tenant organizations, as well as 60,000 Airmen and families in the National Capital Region and around the world. The 316th Wing supports contingency operations in our nation's capital with immediate response rotary-wing assets. The wing also provides security for the world's highest visibility flightline, supporting the President of the United States and other senior leaders.

Col. Oh entered the Air Force in 2002 as a graduate of the Reserve Officer Training Corps from The Ohio State University. He earned his wings in 2004 and is a command pilot with more than 2,200 hours, primarily in the UH-1N Huey helicopter. He has had the privilege of serving in multiple leadership positions across three major commands around the world. Prior to his current assignment, Col. Oh was the 374th Operations Group commander at Yokota Air Base, Japan.
