CMDCM (AW/EXW/SW) TRE FREEMAN III COMMAND MASTER CHIEF, NAF WASHINGTON DC

Command Master Chief Freeman enlisted in the Navy October 2003. Leaving his hometown of Wake Forest, North Carolina, he reported to Recruit Training Command, Great Lakes in April 2004. After completing basic training and Seaman Apprenticeship Training, he reported to the USS Kearsarge (LHD-3) in August of 2004. As an undesignated Seaman assigned to First and Third division, he completed a deployment in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. He was awarded the Combat Action Ribbon in 2005 and also earned his Enlisted Surface Warfare and Enlisted Aviation Warfare qualifications. He reported to Ship's Serviceman "A" school in Meridian, MS and upon completion reported to the USS Philippine Sea (CG-58) in Mayport, FL. Onboard Philippine Sea, he served as the Ship's Store Clerk and Ship Barber and completed two deployments to the Middle East. He left active duty and joined the reserves in April 2008.



In the Navy Reserves, he reported to HSL-60 out of Mayport, FL. While at HSL-60, he served as the Tool Room and Financial Clerk and advanced to the rank of Third Class Petty Officer in May 2009. He put in a Full Time Support (FTS) Package and was selected to the FTS program in December 2009. He received orders and reported to the USS Klakring (FFG-42) in February 2010. While onboard USS Klakring he served in numerous roles and promoted to Second Class Petty Officer and upon her decommissioning in 2013, he transferred to NAVSUP FLC Fort Worth, TX.

At NAVSUP FLC Fort Worth, he promoted to First Class Petty Officer in May 2014 and was selected as the FY15 Command and Regional SOY. He transferred to VR-62 in Jacksonville, FL in March 2016. While at VR-62 he was selected to Chief Petty Officer in August 2017. He reported to Fifth Navy Expeditionary Logistics Regiment (FIFTH NELR) in February of 2018 as the Maintenance & Material Management Coordinator (3MC) and Command Safety Chief. He served as the Command Senior Enlisted Leader from October 2019 to September 2020. He also earned his Expeditionary Warfare Qualification during that tour. In May 2020 he was selected to Senior Chief Petty Officer. In October 2020, he reported to Navy Reserve Region Readiness and Mobilization Command Everett in Everett, WA where he served as the N4/N6 Department Leading Chief Petty Officer. In 2022 he was selected as Command Senior Chief and his first tour was Command Senior Chief at NRC Raleigh, NC. His first Major Command tour was as the

Command Master Chief of Navy Reserve Center Norfolk. He currently serves as Command Master Chief for Joint Base Andrews-Naval Air Facility Washington in Maryland.

Master Chief Freeman's personal awards include Meritorious Service Medal (2), Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (3), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (6), Combat Action Ribbon and numerous campaign and unit awards. He's earned an Bachelor of Science Degree in Organizational Management and an Associate's Degree in General Studies. He is a graduate of CMC/COB class 246 and Senior Enlisted Academy class 238 (grey). Master Chief resides in Accokeek, MD with his wife Blossom, three son's Samuel IV, Emanuel and Nathaniel and soon to be newborn daughter Sasha.
