COLONEL MATTHEW E. JONES

Col. Matthew E. Jones is the Commander, 89th Airlift Wing, Joint Base Andrews, Maryland. He is responsible for worldwide special air mission airlift, logistics, aerial port and communications support for the President, Vice President, cabinet members, combatant commanders, and other senior military and elected leaders as tasked by the White House, Air Force chief of staff and Air Mobility Command. The wing provides 24/7 alert airlift and operates an Executive Airlift Training Center and Government Security Operations Center.

Colonel Jones received his commission from the U.S. Air Force Academy in 1999, where he served as the Cadet Wing Commander and then completed Joint Specialized Undergraduate Pilot Training at Columbus AFB, Miss. His operational assignments include serving as a C-5 Instructor Pilot, Contingency Response Operations Officer and C-5M Squadron Commander. In 2010, he deployed to Haiti and led U.S. Transportation Command's first Joint Task Force Aerial Port Opening.



Colonel Jones was the Air Force's first Intermediate Developmental Education Chief of Staff of the Air Force Scholar at Harvard. He also served on the staff within the Office of the Secretary of Defense as the Special Assistant to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for POW/Missing Persons, and as the Chief of Global Mobility Division, Headquarters Air Force, Arlington, Va. In this capacity, he served as the Career Field Manager for 5,500 mobility pilots and navigators. Prior to his current assignment, he served as Commander, 436th Airlift Wing, Dover AFB, Del.
