COLONEL JENNIFER R. KONDAL

Colonel Jen Kondal is the Vice Commander, Air National Guard Readiness Center, Joint Base Andrews, Maryland. She is responsible for assisting the Air National Guard Readiness Center Commander with resourcing, oversight, guidance and execution of a more than \$11 billion annual appropriation to enable mission readiness of 108,100 military and civilian personnel in 90 wings throughout the United States, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam and the Virgin Islands. Colonel Kondal is dual-hatted as the Commander of the 201st Mission Support Squadron. In this role, she exercises command and control over Air National Guard assigned units and members. She is the Title 10 commander for the nearly 5,000 Air National Guard members serving on Title 10 orders worldwide.

Colonel Kondal enlisted in the Air National Guard in 1990. She earned her commission through the Academy of Military Science in 1995. She held numerous positions as an intelligence officer, including providing support for KC-135 and F-16 flying units. She served as Commander of the 102d Operations Support Squadron as part of the Distributed Common Ground System mission, as the ANG Assistant to the Director of the National Reconnaissance Office, and as the Director of Intelligence, Operations, and Communications for the New York ANG. She has experience as a government civilian in the Office of the Secretary of Defense for Intelligence and previously served as Deputy Director of ANG Operations for Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance Operations, ANG Readiness Center, Joint Base Andrews, Maryland. Prior to her current assignment, she was the Commander, the I.G. Brown Training and Education Center at McGhee Tyson Air National Guard Base in Tennessee.
