






## How Do I Become a SAPR Volunteer Victim Advocate?

-  Obtain Command Approval
-  Submit Volunteer Victim Advocate packet to SAPR VA
-  Schedule an interview with the SARC/SAPR VA
-  Complete 40 Hour SAPR Volunteer Victim Advocate Training
-  Apply to the DoD Sexual Assault Advocate Certification Program

### Requirements:

1. 40 Hour VVA Training Course Certificate
2. Supervisor/Commander Statement of Understanding
3. Supervisor and SARC Letters of Recommendation
4. Tier III or higher background investigation
5. Maintain 32 hours of continuing education units bi-annually

## What Does a SAPR Volunteer Victim Advocate Do?

Provide 24/7 hotline support one week per quarter

Provide crisis intervention

Assist with safety planning

Provide military and community resources and referrals

Provide continuous emotional support from initial meeting through disposition of case

Provide support through initial and ongoing investigation

Accompany and support clients to hospital, investigative interviews, and court proceedings as requested

Plan and support SAPR awareness events

Report directly to the SARC

## Who is Eligible?

- Regular Active Duty, AF Reserve, and ANG personnel
- E-4 and above or O-2 and above (unless prior enlisted)
- AF Civilian Employees GS-7 and above
- At least 1 year retainability in current assignment
- Must be at least 21 years of age

## Who is NOT Eligible?

- Members on G-Series orders, 1st Sgts, CMSgts
- Law enforcement personnel
- SJA and Defense counsel personnel
- EO personnel
- IG personnel
- Wing Chaplain personnel
- Direct patient care Healthcare personnel
