Reporting Options for Adult Victims of Sexual Assault

Restricted Report

Confidential Reporting Eligibility:

- ◆ 18+
- ◆ Military & Dependents
- ◆ DoD AF Civilian Employees

Not Reportable to:

- ◆ Command Team
- ◆ OSI/Law Enforcement

Resources:

- ◆ Medical Care/SAFE
- ◆ Advocacy
- ◆ Victim Counsel (VC)
- ◆ CATCH Program

Unrestricted Report

Reporting Eligibility:

- ◆ 18+
- ◆ Military & Dependents
- ◆ DoD AF Civilian Employees

Reportable to:

- ◆ Command Team
- ◆ OSI

Resources:

- ◆ Command Support
- ◆ Medical Care/SAFE
- ◆ Advocacy
- ◆ Legal Counsel/VC
- ◆ CATCH Program
- ◆ Expedited Transfer

Disclosure to CoC & Independent Reports

Disclosures to the following generates an Independent Report :

- ◆ Supervisors, First Sergeants, Chiefs, Commanders and law enforcement

Victim Reporting Options:

- ◆ Unrestricted
- ◆ Restricted (if the victim did not directly report the incident to law enforcement or OSI)
- ◆ May decline participation in an investigation

CATCH a Serial Offender Program

The CATCH A Serial Offender Program gives SAPR clients an opportunity to anonymously submit suspect information to help the Department of Defense identify serial offenders. In the event of a match the client will be contacted by their SARC.

Victim elects to participate in CATCH

SARC provides username and password

Victim submits entry in CATCH

MCIO will notify SARC if there is a "match"

SARC will notify the Victim of the "match"

Victims can choose to:

- Participate in an investigation
- Decline to participate in an investigation OR
- Withdraw participation in CATCH and receive no additional notifications

Reporting Retaliation for Adult Victims of Sexual Assault

Eligibility

- ◆ Adult victim who previously made an Unrestricted Report
- ◆ Victim's adult family member (e.g., spouse, son, daughter)
- ◆ Witnesses or Bystanders associated with a report
- ◆ Responder
- ◆ Support Personnel including SARCs, Advocates, or SVCs
